U.S.-Mexico border closure | Commercial trade continues

On March 20, 2020, the governments of the United States and Mexico announced a full closure of the U.S.-Mexico border to non-essential travel. The announcement effectively seals off the U.S. border from travelers arriving from a number of countries, including Canada, China, Mexico, Iran and numerous European nations, including the United Kingdom and Ireland.

It is important to understand that these border and entry restrictions do not apply to the movement and/or passage of commercial goods across borders. Trade will continue to take place between the U.S. and Mexico on land, in the air and at sea.
